Who must be trained and certified for applying pesticides? According to Alaska state law, all individuals who:

- Purchase, use or sell U.S. Environmental Protection Agency restricted use pesticide (RUPs).
- Supervise the use of RUPs.
- Use or supervise the use of pesticides at a public place, such as a park, school, or common area of an apartment building, government office or public sports field (excluding antimicrobials).
- Apply pesticides to someone else's property. This includes all "weed and feed" products.
- Advise or consult about pesticide use.
